Save The Children release list of best and worst countries to live as a girl and the U.S. ranks 32nd, below Algeria and above Tunisia. Some countries could not be rated.

Highlighted:

The criteria for this list are rates of: child marriage, teen pregnancy, maternal mortality, high school graduation, and the percentages of female lawmakers.

Scandinavian countries fared best (with Sweden topping the list) and all in the top 10 are in Europe.

Issues:

In the Global Development Index, the U.S. economy ranks 8th, but we have high rates of teenage pregnancy and low female representation in Congress (just 20% of the Senate and as 19.3% of the House of Representatives). Also, 14 women died per 100,000 live births in the USA last year (the same as Uruguay and Lebanon).

Altamont Concert Anniversary

Highlighted:

The infamous free concert (held at the Altamont Speedway in Livermore, California) featuring performances by the Rolling Stones, Jefferson Airplane, Santana, and Crosby, Stills, Nash & Young , and others turned into tragedy. The "thank-you" concert for 300,000 fans was marred by overcrowding, drug overdoses and the fatal stabbing of a spectator by a member of the Hell's Angels motorcycle gang, who had been hired as security guards for the event.
